

Test Day Reminders

- Candidate must bring a picture I.D. to present to the proctor when they login to the UniversalLanguage proctoring partner site.
- Candidate should test their computers audio and video quality before login to the proctoring testing site.
- The candidate must make sure their testing space (office, bedroom, or private workspace) are free of pets, other individuals, and all noise and distractions during testing time.
- The written and oral test will begin and end as scheduled. Therefore, if the candidate arrives late to the test but still decides to proceed, they will be taking the test at their loss of time.
- During the test candidate cannot use reference materials, including dictionaries, glossaries, or medical terminology books. No electronic devices of any kind will be allowed during the testing time.
- Candidate can bring blank paper and a pen or pencil to the test and **MUST** shredded upon finishing the test.
- Candidate must remember they are being proctored during the test and must maintain professional etiquette during the test time. There is to be no talking, eating, smoking, drinking, etc.... during the testing time.
- Any cheating behavior, if discovered by the live and recorded proctoring, can and may result in the cancellation of a candidate's eligibility for taking the test.
